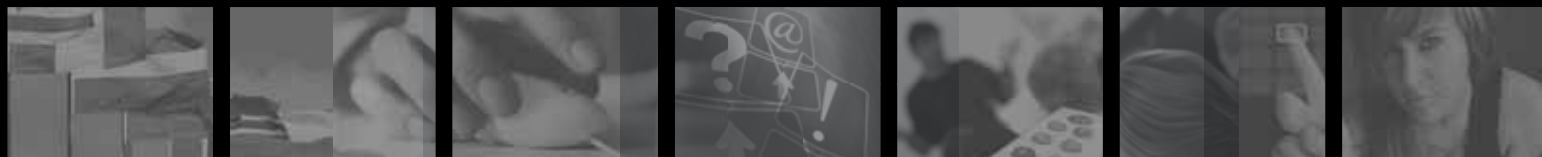

LEGISLATION

The area of spills is one with many legal constraints, including the following:

- Water Resources Act 1991
- Protection of Groundwater Regulations 1998
- The Environmental Protection (Duty of Care) Regulations 1991
- Control of Pollution (Oil Storage) Regulations 2001
- The Dangerous Substances and Explosive Atmospheres Regulations 2002

If your company is found to have broken any of these laws you will face fines and bad publicity.
